SUMMER PROGRAM SCHEDULE

The **2018 Summer Program** at Muckykids Art Studio is a drop-off program that offers kids aged 5 - 12 a unique opportunity to indulge, explore, and expand their love of art and craft. For three mornings or afternoons a week over 6 summer weeks in June, July and August, kids can participate in intensive, hands-on art workshops diving into a variety of weekly themes.

The program is divided by age group; the **9:00 a.m. to noon section for 5 – 7 year olds**, and the **1:00 pm to 4:00 pm section for 8 – 12 year olds**. Registration is flexible; sign up for the individual weeks that interest you, or sign up for all 6 weeks for a discounted tuition. The program runs on **Mondays, Tuesdays, and Wednesdays**, from June 25th to August 15th (no camp during the weeks of July 2nd and July 9th). The fee is \$195 per week, or a discounted tuition of \$995 for all six weeks.

Week 1 (June 25 – June 27) – Bookmaking

Bookmaking is an ancient craft that we will explore, while adding our own twists. We will play with sewn bindings, tape bindings, twig bindings, and even no binding (accordion fold and scrolls)! Collage, stamping, fabric and repurposed pages will fill these one-of-a-kind creations, some so tiny that they can fit into a matchbox. Fee: \$195

Week 2 (July 16 – July 18) – Sculpture

In this workshop we will look at additive and reductive forms of sculpture and play with kinetic vs. static sculpture. Some of the materials that we will sculpt with are: wood and glue, spray painted paper plates, craft foam and wire, air dry clay, flanged cardboard, and upcycled supplies. We will look at Pablo Picasso, Alexander Calder, Tara Donovan and Andy Goldsworthy as inspiration. Fee: \$195

Week 3 (July 23 – July 25) – Printmaking

In this workshop we will explore some of the many many forms of printmaking. We will carve printing plates, build printing plates, print with found objects, print with nature, and make our own stamps. We will print, draw into, and collect artist trading cards. We will make paper pouches to collect the cards in. Some of the printed pieces will be turned into hanging sculpture! And finally, the students will curate and choose two of their favorite prints to frame. Fee: \$195

Week 4 (July 30 – August 1) – Art and Science

What fun it is to make rainbows with prisms, pull magnets with other magnets, and spin paper sculptures with closed circuits! In this workshop we will explore ways to combine science and art. We will make and decorate 'rainbow catchers'. We will pull magnets thru paint. We will build temporary light sculptures. Some of the other activities will include: color mixing with liquids, printing with bubbles, making potions, pendulum painting, and making reflection garlands! Fee: \$195

Week 5 (August 6 – August 8) – Art and Nature

In this workshop we'll expand on a favorite theme at Muckykids: combining traditional crafting techniques with found objects from nature. We will be printing with leaves, embellishing stones, building dioramas, making nature wands, and more. We will also make sun catchers, craft cork people for our dioramas, have fun making animal puppets, sculpting figures with oven bake clay, and planting beans that they can care for. Fee: \$195

Week 6 (August 13 – August 15) – Fiber Art

Fabric, yarn, and string will be the basis for an interesting variety of projects. We will make hanging string sculptures, made rigid with a glue solution. We will 'quilt' with fusible fabrics and iron-on gems. We will sew felt animals. We will even use a marbling technique on fabric in the process of making a wall hanging. Fee: \$195

POLICIES

The following policies govern classes, Summer program, and drop-in studio sessions at Muckykids. Please feel free to contact us (617-354-0540 or info@muckykids.com) to discuss any of these policies prior to registering for a class or summer session.

Registration Process

- * Advance registration is required for all class series and Summer program. We recommend that you call us to ensure space.
- * When your registration is received and processed, we'll contact you to confirm. Be sure to include correct contact information on the registration form.
- * For ongoing class series: late registration (joining a class after the series has begun) is possible on a space-available basis prior to the third week.

Fees

- * Class/program fee includes all materials.
- * Class/program fee is due upon registration and is required in order to guarantee your child's spot. The complete fee must be fully paid prior to attendance.

Cancellation and Refunds

- * You may cancel your registration for a class series or Summer week before it begins for a full refund.
- * No refund will be given for withdrawal from an ongoing class series after the third class begins.
- * Each family is allowed two make-up classes. These are in the form of drop-in studio time and expire after one year.
- * If Muckykids needs to cancel a class due to inclement weather or illness, we will attempt to contact you with as much advance notice as possible. If we have to cancel a class, we will offer a make-up class after the scheduled end of the class series.

Parent+Child or Drop-Off

- * We love having parents stay and participate. Parents are welcome to participate in any class for any age of kids.
- * Classes for 1- and 2-year-olds and Drop-In Studio are "parent+child" only; stay and get mucky with your little one!
- * Summer program and classes for 3-year-olds and up are "drop-off optional." We must have complete contact information for you on your child's registration form if you plan to drop off.
- * For classes, if you do want to drop off your child, please plan to return 5 minutes before the scheduled end of the class to help your child gather up his or her work and pack up. Call us at 617-354-0540 if you'll be late to avoid any anxiety for us or for your artist!
- * Drop-off for the morning Summer program is from 8:45 to 9:00, and pickup is from 11:45 to 12:00 noon. Drop-off for the afternoon Summer program is from 12:45 to 1:00, and pickup is from 3:45 to 4:00.

Conserving Materials

- * Drop-In Studio prices and class/program fees always include all materials. It's all about experimentation and exploration, and sometimes that means you need some extras! However, we do request that you keep an eye on your little ones to help us to conserve resources by preventing unnecessary waste.

Snacks, Allergies, and Wellness

- * Muckykids classes do not have snack time; however, you may bring snacks for your child.
- * Summer program does have snack time; please send your child's snack in with them.
- * Please do not bring any peanut-based snacks or hot drinks into the Studio.
- * Please do not bring a sick child to the Studio. We want to keep everyone healthy!
